



# MANDATORY DETAILS FOR ENTRY

Trinity Beach Sports Club is operating under an approved Industry COVID Safe Plan, with strict COVID-19 guidelines and various restrictions in place to ensure the safety of our patrons and staff. In accordance with QLD Government legislation, contact information must be supplied and kept for all customers who are dining-in or drinking.

We will have many precautions in place to protect the health and well-being of our staff and patrons at all times, including but not limited to: strict social distancing enforced, maximum patron limits for all areas, entry conditions, additional sanitisation of all areas and touch points, and hand sanitiser stations readily available throughout the club.

**We encourage you to keep a keen eye out for social distancing, and practice exemplary personal and respiratory hygiene.** Our staff will be on hand to monitor and help you. If you have any questions or concerns, please see your nearest staff member. Please actively monitor and move away from anyone who is within your 1.5m of personal space.

**If you are sick in anyway, please do not come to the club,** see a doctor, stay at home, and follow all medical advice. We have the right to refuse service to patrons who are unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms, and by law, must ensure that anyone with these symptoms leave the premises.
